The luxurious sleepwear from Body Linens by Thread Count is made from the finest 100% Egyptian cotton and features fun extras such as genuine mother-of-pearl buttons and French seams for a finished look. And, they're tagless. Choose from the nightie, a cami and Capri set, as well as a classic button-down shirt and pants for women. There's also one for the men. Specify whether you want the 300, 500 or 800 thread count. You can even get the pajamas monogrammed for an extra personal touch.
